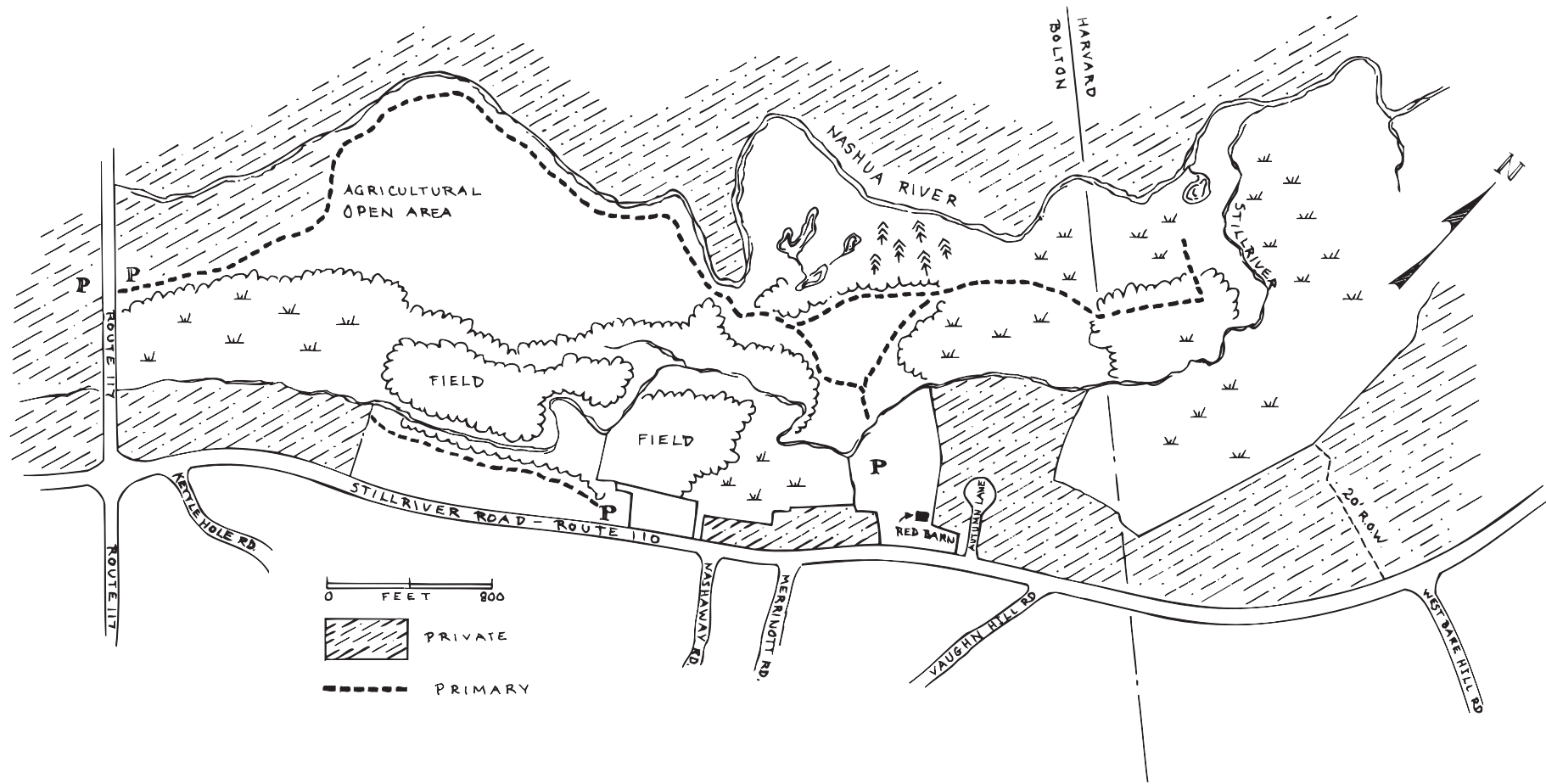


BOLTON FLATS



The Bolton Flats Wildlife Management Area encompasses a 923 acre floodplain of the Nashua and Still Rivers. Access is off routes 110 and 117. The agricultural fields are interspersed with hedgerows, floodplain hardwoods and wetlands shrubs. The wildlife in this area includes stocked pheasant, aquatic furbearers, grouse, woodcocks, herons, crows, raptors and numerous non-game species. Of special interest is the great variety of birds the area supports, especially at migration periods. The area is open to hunting in season. Visitors should check the posted hunting schedules or check hunting schedules at Town Hall.
