
KAUFMANN LAND



The Kaufmann land was acquired by the Conservation Commission in 1979 as a vital link between Holy Hill (see pages 26 and 27) to the north and the Town Forest to the south. Starting opposite the Holy Hill parking lot, the trail winds through the predominantly oak woods in an area that is gently sloping and becomes more rugged as one progresses. In the south, the Kaufmann land connects with the part of the Town Forest cut off by Route 2. The trail ends at Poor Farm Road by White Lane. From there you may cross over Route 2 and continue in the southern part of the Town Forest.

Adjacent lands to the west of the original parcels have been conveyed to the Conservation Commission in the course of land development. A secondary trail over land donated to the town by Lou Russo leads to a dramatic rock outcropping and ends in a dense hemlock forest.

Approximate walking time for primary trail: 25 mins. one way - moderate
