
PROSPECT HILL



This 61-acre parcel was given to the Town in 1971. From the entrance on Prospect Hill Road, there is a beautiful view across the valley to the Southern New Hampshire mountains. The trail winds through typical Harvard hardwoods, including some good specimens of beech, white birch, hemlock and witch hazel. It also passes several rock outcroppings. Many private trails cross the main trail; follow the yellow blazes. If you branch off on the secondary trail for a short distance you may see some mountain laurel and a little farther along there is a fine stand of white pine. From this land you may connect with the Ryan land to Harvard Depot Road.

Approximate walking time for main trail: 1 1/4 hours - moderate
